### STAY EXTENSION

1. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that the Applicants' motion scheduled for October 1, 2024 is hereby adjourned to October 31, 2024.

2. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that the Stay Period, as ordered and defined in paragraph 18 of the Initial Order granted March 12, 2019 (as amended and restated from time to time) is hereby extended up to and including October 31, 2024.
