UPON THE APPLICATION of McBurney Power Limited (the "Applicant"), a wholly owned subsidiary of The McBurney Corporation ("McBurney"); AND UPON reading the Affidavit of John Curtis McBurney, sworn December 17, 2012, filed; AND UPON hearing the submissions of Counsel for the Applicant and any other counsel in attendance at the application; AND UPON it appearing appropriate in the circumstances to grant this recognition order;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

SERVICE

1. The time for service of notice of this Application and supporting materials is hereby abridged and validated and further service of the Application and supporting materials is hereby dispensed with.

FOREIGN REPRESENTATIVE

2. The Foreign Representative is the "foreign representative" as defined in section 45 of the CCAA of McBurney in respect of the Chapter 11 proceedings commenced pursuant to the *United States Code* (the "Foreign Proceeding").

CENTRE OF MAIN INTEREST AND RECOGNITION OF FOREIGN PROCEEDING

3. The centre of main interests for McBurney is recognized as the Northern District of Georgia, in the United States of America in which the Foreign Proceeding was filed and the Foreign Proceeding is hereby recognized as a "foreign main proceeding", as defined in section 45 of the CCAA.

STAY OF PROCEEDINGS

- 4. Until otherwise ordered by this Court:
 - (a) Further proceedings in any action, suit or proceedings against McBurney are restrained; and
 - (b) The commencement of any action, suit or proceeding against McBurney is prohibited.

NO SALE OF PROPERTY

- 5. Except with leave of this Court, McBurney is prohibited from selling or otherwise disposing of:
 - (a) Outside the ordinary course of its business, any of its property in Canada that relates to the business; and
 - (b) Any of its other property in Canada.

GENERAL

- 6. Within 7 days from the date of this Order, or as soon as practicable thereafter, the Foreign Representative shall cause to be published a notice substantially in the form attached to this Order as Schedule "A" once a week for two consecutive weeks, in the Globe and Mail (National Edition).
- 7. This Court hereby requests the aid and recognition of any court, tribunal, regulatory or administrative body having jurisdiction in Canada, the United States or elsewhere, to give effect to this Order and to assist McBurney and the Foreign Representative and their respective counsel and agents in carrying out the terms of this Order. All courts, tribunals, regulatory and administrative bodies are hereby respectfully requested to make such orders and to provide such assistance to McBurney and the Foreign Representative as may be necessary or desirable to give effect to this Order or to assist McBurney and the Foreign Representative and their respective agents in carrying out the terms of this Order.
- 8. Any interest party may apply to this Court to vary or amend this Order or to seek other relief on not less than seven (7) days' notice to McBurney and the Foreign Representative and their respective counsel, and to any other party or parties likely to affected by the order sought, or upon such other notice, if any, as this Court may order.
- 9. This Order shall be served on all affected parties, including all Persons in Canada listed in the Voluntary Petition found at Exhibit "A" to the Affidavit of John Curtis McBurney, sworn December 17, 2012.
