

UPON THE APPLICATION of RS Technologies Inc. ("RS" or the "Company"); AND UPON reading the Affidavit of Howard R. Elliott, sworn June 19, 2013, filed; AND UPON reading the Third Report of the Monitor, dated June 21, 2013 (the "Third Report"), filed; AND UPON reading the Affidavit of Service of Ashley Rees sworn June 20, 2013, filed; AND UPON hearing from counsel to the Company, the Monitor, and other interested parties;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The questioning of Galen Fecht by Armor Utility Structures Pty Limited ("**Armor**") on his affidavit sworn June 13, 2013, if required, shall be completed by July 5, 2013.
2. Armor shall file and serve its brief of law for its application (the "**Armour Application**") to prohibit the disclaimer of a distribution agreement dated March 30, 2012 (the "**Distribution Agreement**") between Armor and RS by July 10, 2013.
3. RS shall file and serve its brief of law for the Armor Application by July 12, 2013.
4. The Armor Application will be scheduled through the Trial Coordinator's office.
5. Any interest party may apply to this Court to vary or amend this Order on not less than one (1) day's notice to any other party or parties likely to be affected by the order sought or upon such other notice, if any, as this Court may order.
6. This Order may be approved in any number of counterparts and by facsimile transmission or PDF, each of which when executed shall be deemed to be an original and all of which when taken together shall constitute one and the same instrument.
