Claim for OPEBs (Post-employment benefits). Mr. Hart was hired on June 26th 1976. He was injured at work on December 26th 1983. He continued working until January 24th 1984, when the pain has forced him to stop. He has been on Workers compensation since that day. Mr. Hart was unlawfully terminated in 2006. His termination was contested in various forums and a settlement was reached in 2008. This settlement provided for insurance coverage just like any retiree from Wabush Mines. Therefore, his claim should be treated as all the other OPEBs claims were. Claim amount was calculated by Segal using the same methodology.

To help protect your privacy, Cliffs Wabush Mines and Sun Life Financial have decided to change your Member ID so that it's no longer based on your Social Insurance number (SIN). (Your Member ID number identifies your eligibility for your group benefits plan.)

As a result, on September 1st, 2011 your Member ID number will change. Your new ID number will be your Cliffs Wabush Mines employee number. In your case, your new ID number will be: 14664

Here's what you need to know:

- **When you submit paper health claims**
Until August 31, 2011, you can continue to use your current Member ID when you submit paper health claims.
As of September 1st, 2011, you'll start using your new Member ID (14664). Just write your new Member ID on your claim form when submitting claims.
If you are in possession of pre-completed claim forms with your Social Security Number, we invite you to destroy them in order to avoid confusion.
- **When you submit claims online (Internet)**
The Access ID and PIN number you use to sign on to the Sun Life Financial Plan Member Services website will not change. You can continue to submit claims online as usual.
- **When you go to the pharmacy with your Pay-Direct Drug card**
Your current Pay-Direct Drug (PDD) card is good until September 30, 2011.
You'll receive a new PDD card by mid-September. Once you receive your new card, please discard the old one.
Once you have your new card, just bring it with you the next time you go to the pharmacy. Your pharmacist needs your new Member ID (14664) in order to submit drug claims electronically on your behalf. This also applies for all your covered dependants (if any).
