Claim for OPEBs (Post-employment benefits). Mr. Pevie has been employed in Scully since September 3rd 1980. He was injured outside of work around November 6th 1998. He has been on insurance benefits since that day, including LTD benefits as he was permanently unable to work. Under the insurance agreement, Mr. Pevie was entitled to maintain insurance coverage and employment relationship with Wabush Mines with he continued to receive LTD Benefits. Mr. Pevie had to retire at the age of 65, as per the terms of the insurance agreement. At the date of retirement, his insurance coverage was to be automatically converted to post-employment Life and Health insurance, just like all the other OPEBs beneficiaries. Therefore, his claim should be treated as all the other OPEBs claims were. Claim amount was calculated by Segal using the same methodology.




