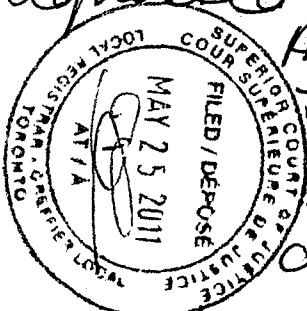

On May 16, 2011 I heard a motion brought by Postmedia relating to ~~an~~ outstanding claims of retired Typographers. At that time, it was suggested by me that a settlement conference that encompassed all Typographer claims might be worthwhile. On May 26, 2011, counsel for Postmedia advised the monitor that it was his client's view that such a conference would be premature. In the circumstances, as the claims continue to be outstanding, the extension to the final distribution date is required. I am \therefore granting the order requested in that regard.
