We are solicitors for the Indalex SERP Protection Committee (the "Committee"), a committee of former salaried employees of Indalex Limited and/or one of its subsidiaries or affiliates (collectively, "Indalex Canada" or the "company").

The Committee represents former salaried employees (or their surviving spouses) who are members of the Supplementary Retirement Plan for Executive Employees of Indalex Canada and Associated Companies, a contract which provides supplementary pension benefits to certain retired employees (the "SERP"). The Committee has retained our firm in respect of the termination of their SERP benefits by Indalex Canada, which is in proceedings under the Companies' Creditors Arrangement Act (the "CCAA").

We have been advised that the company stopped paying our clients their monthly SERP benefits immediately after it obtained protection from its creditors under the CCAA on April 3, 2009. The sudden cessation by the company of such retirement benefits has caused immediate financial hardship to our retiree clients.



We are writing to request that the company immediately reinstate our clients' supplemental pension benefits and to issue a make up payment in the amount of the benefits not paid since the payments were ceased by the company.

The amount of the monthly SERP payments to which our clients are entitled is approximately \$19,792, a nominal amount, and are set out as follows:

- Max Degen (Age 76): Mr. Degen was Vice-President, Manufacturing Services of Indalex Limited and is entitled to a monthly benefit payment of \$645.59.
- Keith Carruthers (Age 67): Mr. Carruthers was CEO of Indalex Limited and is entitled to a monthly benefit payment of \$3570.50.
- Leon Kozierok (Age 67): Mr. Kozierok was President of Indalloy Division, Indalex Limited and is entitled to a monthly benefit payment of \$4,325.80.
- Bertram McBride (Age 61): Mr. McBride was Key Account Manager with Indalex Limited and is entitled to a monthly benefit payment of \$2,082.92.
- Eugene D'Iorio (Age 64): Mr. D'Iorio was President, Indalex South Region of Indalex Limited and is entitled to a monthly benefit payment of \$2,249.23.
- Neil Fraser (Age 70): Mr. Fraser was President / CEO of Caradon Windows and Doors Ltd. (an affiliate and/or predecessor company to Indalex Canada) and is entitled to a monthly benefit payment of \$2,800.73.
- Dick Smith (Age 59): Mr. Smith was General Manager of Indalex Vancouver prior to taking a position with Indalex U.S. as President of Mideast Aluminium. Mr. Smith is entitled to a monthly benefit payment of \$3,831.74.
- Robert B. Leckie (Age 61): Mr. Leckie was Vice President and General Counsel of Indal Limited from 1988 to 1993 and is entitled to a monthly benefit payment of \$1,750.00.

CCAA and Chapter 11 Proceedings

Despite filing for CCAA protection, Indalex Canada maintains a positive cash flow and has access to substantial financing.¹ The Initial CCAA Application materials indicate that the Applicants' CCAA filing sought to allow Indalex Canada to stabilize its business and to seek a long term strategic going concern solution for its business operations.² We understand that the proceedings in Canada were pursued in order to maintain coordination and stability between Indalex Canada and Indalex U.S. and resulted in a DIP Agreement which provides the Applicants with loan facility of up to \$24.36 million.³

The Cash Flow Forecast also indicates that Indalex Canada will maintain an excess in credit availability throughout the April 7 forecast.

Indalex Canada has chosen to stop benefit payments to our clients who are members of the SERP. We are advised that our clients received their last SERP benefit payment in March 2009. It is unfair for Indalex Canada to discriminate against our clients in this manner, particularly when the cost of continuing the benefit payments is negligible to the company. As membership to the plan is closed, the company's SERP liability is finite and readily manageable. As noted, the cost of the monthly benefit payment amounts is approximately \$19,792. Yet the benefits provide vital income for our clients in their retirement years.

Making the SERP payments to our clients will not impair the restructuring efforts of Indalex Canada or Indalex U.S.

Please confirm that our clients' SERP benefits will be reinstated forthwith and a retroactive payment issued in the amount of the benefits terminated to date.

("Indalex Canada") et al. (collectively, the "Applicants")

Re: Members of the Supplementary Retirement Plan for Executive Employees

We make reference to your letter dated May 29, 2009 and the subsequent clarification e-mail from your firm dated June 1, 2009, both addressed to counsel for the Applicants and counsel for the Court-appointed Monitor in these proceedings. We do not agree with the premise of your letter and a number of the statements contained therein.

The purpose of the Applicants' CCAA proceedings is to preserve value for a broad cross-section of stakeholders including employees, customers, business partners, suppliers and secured and other creditors. Indalex Canada fully appreciates that the steps it is required to take during the restructuring process may create significant challenges for many of these stakeholders. These steps, however, are consistent with its obligations to deal with its broad stakeholder constituency in a fair and even-handed manner. Indalex Canada's ultimate goal is to secure a going concern solution for its business that provides the best possible result for these stakeholders as a whole. The restructuring steps taken by the Applicants, in accordance with the Initial Order (as amended), are done in furtherance of that goal.

Accordingly, Indalex Canada is not in a position to comply with the request set out in your letter to reinstate payments to the group of pre-filing unsecured creditors represented by your firm. It is Indalex Canada's view that such payments would be preferential in nature and would unduly deplete Indalex Canada's vital cash resources. In that regard, and as set out in our court material, Indalex Canada's availability is restricted by the borrowing base provided for in the DIP Credit Agreement and limited to the amounts required to meet immediate working capital needs.
