THIS COURT ORDERS that:


1. Clark Wilson LLP be authorized and directed to hold or distribute the funds held pursuant to paragraph 10 of the Order pronounced December 12, 2018 in the proceedings (the "Proceeds") as follows:

- (a) to continue to hold \$1,955,000, plus any applicable taxes, on account of a claim by Harjinder Singh Berar, Karmjit Kaur Berar, Berar Farms Ltd., and Nelson Road Investments Ltd. against the Proceeds; and
- (b) to continue to hold \$1,778,724.57 on account of the deemed trust claim of Canada Revenue Agency against the Proceeds; and
- (c) to distribute the balance to the FTI Consulting Canada Inc., in its capacity as court-appointed Monitor of the Petitioners.

2. The stay of proceedings provided for in the Initial Order pronounced on October 11, 2018, as extended by the Orders pronounced November 2, 2018, December 12, 2018, February 6, 2019, April 12, 2019, May 6 and May 8, is hereby extended to September 30, 2019.

3. The approval of counsel as to form listed as **Schedule "A"** hereto, except for counsel for the Petitioners, is dispensed with.


