UPON the application of FTI Consulting Canada Inc. ("FTI"), in its capacity as receiver and manager (the "Receiver") of Solara Exploration Ltd. the ("Debtor"), AND UPON having read the Third Report of the Receiver, dated September 3, 2014 (the "Third Report"), filed, AND UPON having read the Affidavit of Service of Ashley Rees, filed; AND UPON HEARING counsel for the Receiver and counsel for other interested parties;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND DIRECTED THAT:

1. Service of the Application is hereby abridged, if necessary, such that the Application is properly returnable today and, further, that any requirement for service of the Application upon any party not served is hereby dispensed with.

- 2. Capitalized terms not otherwise defined herein shall have the meaning given to them in the Third Report.
- 3. FTI is hereby unconditionally and absolutely discharged as Receiver of the Property (as such term is defined in the Receivership Order). The Receiver shall have no further duty, liability or obligation with respect to the Property.  - (c) the Receiver shall not be liable for any act or omission pertaining to the discharge of the Receiver's duties as receiver of the Property, save and except for any liability arising out of fraud or gross negligence or wilful misconduct on the part of the Receiver; and
 - (d) any and all claims against the Receiver arising from, relating to or in connection with the performance of the Receiver's duties and obligations as receiver of the Property, save and expect for claims based on fraud or gross negligence or wilful misconduct on the part of the Receiver, shall be forever barred and extinguished.
- 5. No action or proceedings arising from, relating to, or in connection with the performance of the Receiver's duties and obligations in respect of the Debtor and the Property may be commenced or continued without the prior leave of this Honourable Court, on notice to the Receiver and on such terms as this Honourable Court may direct.

- 6. FTI's Statement of Receipts and Disbursements set out in the Third Report is hereby approved and the Receiver is hereby directed and authorized to make the distributions set out therein.
- 7. FTI's accounts and the accounts of its independent legal counsel are hereby approved.
- 8.
